Time	Morning Activities
8.00-8.30 am	<p style="text-align: center;">‘Early Bird Club’</p> <p>Here children can be dropped off at the Dining Hall for a substantial hot/cold breakfast where children will be supervised by junior staff.</p>
8.30-8.45am	<p style="text-align: center;">Before school playtime</p> <p>Early Bird pupils return to St Nicholas for outdoor play/activities. Other pupils arrive at the school playground with their parents.</p>
8.45-8.55 am	<p style="text-align: center;">Registration</p> <p>School bell will ring to signal the start of the school day. Time to go into school, settle into class, read quietly or prepare for assembly.</p>
8.55-9.15 am	<p style="text-align: center;">Assembly/Chapel</p> <p>Assembly, where we learn about the wider world and spirituality, sing hymns and recognise outstanding achievements or contributions. Pupils will enjoy assembly at St Nicholas or at the Neuadd. We will also attend chapel once a fortnight.</p>
9.15-10.25 am	<p style="text-align: center;">Lesson 1</p> <p>First lesson of the day. This is usually Literacy or Numeracy.</p>
10.25-10.45 am	<p style="text-align: center;">Break time</p> <p>Pupils can play on our Adventure and Agility structure with our fantastic timber tangle. Others may decide on a kick about on the Astro Turf. Some pupils may be having an instrumental lesson; from piano to percussion.</p>
10.45 am -12.00 pm	<p style="text-align: center;">Lesson 2</p> <p>The second lesson of the day will usually be Literacy or Numeracy.</p>

12.00-1.00 pm	<p style="text-align: center;">Lunchtime</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Time for the whole school including the staff to head for the Dining Hall. St Nicholas pupils will enjoy a delicious, healthy and balanced meal with good manners and etiquette at the heart of meal time.</p>
1.00-2.05 pm	<p style="text-align: center;">Lesson 3</p> <p>Back to class. Pupils may be receiving a Music lesson in the Music School with our specialist teachers or getting busy in our 'Messy room' whilst doing cookery, Science or Art. We will explore our topics in the afternoons and may be learning about Rivers or how to be a Global Gourmet!</p>
2.05-3.15 pm	<p style="text-align: center;">Lesson 4</p> <p>In the afternoons, children will enjoy a weekly PE lesson in the school's sports facilities, or perhaps visit the school's Science laboratory for a Science lesson with a specialist teacher (Y6). This is also a time where they will learn French, History, Geography, IT and lots lots more.</p>

3.15-3.30 pm	<p style="text-align: center;">Story time, fill in prep diaries and tidy up time</p>
3.30-3.45 pm	<p style="text-align: center;">Daily K/Fitness Frenzy & Snack time</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Time for a snack and a drink before getting ready for either Games or supervised prep/clubs.</p>
3.45-4.50 pm (5.00 pm pick up option 1)	<p style="text-align: center;">Mon and Thurs -Games (compulsory for all)</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Monday and Thursday afternoons are also the time when pupils participate in Games sessions with our specialist sports teachers.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Tues/Weds/Fri- Homework/Prep (3.45-4.15pm)</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Energy replenished, pupils will then have time to complete any homework set by their teacher. This is a supervised session and will avoid pupils needing to bring homework home.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Tues/Weds/Fri - Activities (4.15-4.50pm)</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Extra-curricular school clubs.
